Remember Easter

The time leading up to Easter is perfect for diving into the scriptures to prepare your heart for the coming celebrations. To help you get started, here are two verses I think will prepare your heart for this Easter Sunday.

"But I know that my redeemer lives, and at the end he will stand on the dust" ([Job 19:25](#)).

Job was a man who never met Jesus. He was ridiculed by his friends and experienced physical pain with no relief, yet he had a hope that we too can hold on to today. Job knew that His redeemer lived and would relieve him of his earthly chaos. We have a redeemer in Christ. When Jesus rose on the third day, he stood on the dust. He proved He was the Messiah that would rule over the Earth.

"But he was pierced because of our rebellion, crushed because of our iniquities; punishment for our peace was on him, and we are healed by his wounds" ([Isaiah 53:5](#)).

Isaiah was a prophet speaking seven hundred years before the birth of Jesus. Today, we have the knowledge that his prophetic message came to fruition. This truth makes his words even more powerful.
